Vision

To serve and reach ten lakh people of marginalized sections of society by 2030 by supporting and making efforts to provide benefits on which they have due right and make tobacco free Uttarakhand in 2040

- To provide education to marginalized sections through formal and innovative non–formal programs.
- Formation of Self-Help Groups and credit linkage with bank and to provide financial support through microfinance activities.
- To work on preventive health measures with special focus on health issues such as TB, HIV-AIDS control program, Tobacco Control Program etc.
- To sensitize, raise the level of awareness on legal, political, social and economical rights in the poor and marginalized communities.
- To undertake activities to promote peace and harmony among the society.
- To promote skill development program among women, youths of urban and rural area.
- To support the activities on financial inclusion.
- To support Govt. policies which aimed at alleviating poverty, creation of jobs in the resemi urban and urban slum areas, and in other developmental activities

HIV-AIDS (Target Intervention) Program

Uttarakhand State AIDS Control Society (USACS) has entrusted us the project to locate, identify and to ensure the delivery of quality HIV prevention interventions to high risk 15000 migrant and 5000 Truckers in Dehradun district and 5000 transit population in Ghanshali in Tehri district. This is the yearly based target and BSS has been working with USACS from 2011.

Targeted interventions are a resource-effective way to implement HIV prevention and care Programs in settings with low-level and concentrated HIV epidemics. They are also a cost-effective method of reaching people who are most at risk in more generalized epidemics. Targeted interventions are aimed at offering prevention and care services to high risk populations (Female Sex Workers- FSW, Male having Sex with Male- MSM and Injecting Drug Users- IDUs) within communities by providing them with the information, means and skills they need to minimize HIV transmission and improving their access to care, support and treatment services.

Apart from prevention of HIV infection, TIs facilitate prevention and treatment of sexually transmitted diseases as they increase the risk of HIV infection, and are linked to care, support and treatment services for HIV infected. The TI is implemented through the NGOs. We have been entrusted with working with the migrant population in Dehradun. Dehradun, being capital has become major hub of employment having thousands of migrant laborers. Lot of industries has come up in Selaqui attracting manpower from other states too. Many service, malls, big brands retails and Transport Nagar, ISBT, etc. have come to the city after becoming the capital Main labour source are: UP (56%), Bihar (38%), Uttarakhand (4%), Other (2%). Most of the migrants work as laborer and mobility to their home states is twice a year. While singles frequently change job and move more often, married mostly stay at their workplace and visit their home states once a year at festive seasons.

Under this HIV-AIDS (Target Intervention) Program last year 2021-22 cover more than 15000 migrant population in Dehradun district and provide them all services including organize a free health camp, medicine distribution free testing, condom distribution for these migrant population

The Organization also Educate migrants about the use and benefits of using condoms for living a healthy and protective life through nukkar natak as well as using IEC materails. Last year we have found more than 5 new positive cases which is very alarming and challenges increasing day to day basis.

It is the policy of BSS, to always be in emotional and social touch with our beneficiaries. Our team celebrates local & national festivals, as and when the occasion arises, amongst the migrant workers every year. Contributing and sharing their joy. Our team celebrated International AIDS day every year on 1st Dec as well as Chhat Puja with migrants labourer of Bihar, Holi Milansamaroh, Cricket match etc.





Strengthen Tobacco Control in Uttarakhand through Technical support, Capacity building, multi-stakeholder engagement, enforcement of legislation and countering Tobacco industry interference

The project implemented over the period of 18 months supported the State Tobacco Control Cell and District Tobacco Control Cells in establishing institutional framework for tobacco control, strengthened the mechanism within existing system for implementation of National Tobacco Control Program and effective enforcement of COTPA 2003. The Project grant facilitated to build network, coalitions and strengthened their capacity to prioritize tobacco control at State and district level. During the grant life, the project team regularly monitored, recorded, and documented tobacco industry interreference and has been supporting to formulate and adopt FCTC Article 5.3 Policy, in framing rules of Tobacco vendor license to combat the challenges of TII at all levels, enforcement of ban on hookah and e-cigarettes. The project team efforts resulted into increase of enforcement drives, timely conducting SLCC and DLCC, regular review meetings and establishment of Cessation Centres at the block levels.

During the grant period, the timely and concerted efforts resulted into implementation of a stern Tobacco Control Policy implying no use/sale/advertisement of tobacco within the Kumbh Mela, Haridwar. World No Tobacco Day was celebrated twice during the grant life. The Department of Panchayati, Govt. of Uttarakhand supported our initiative in making Tobacco-free Panchayats and our collaborative efforts resulted in declaration of 21 Gram Panchayats covering 74 villages as Tobacco-Free Villages on different occasions.

With our continuous follow up, Government of Uttarakhand prohibited the Sale of Tobacco Products and imposed heavy penalty for spitting in Public. Advisory issued by Director General Health & Family Welfare on not to consume tobacco products.

Uttarakhand Tobacco-Free Coalition (UTFC) formed and quarterly meetings were conducted. The review meetings were attended by renowned doctors, Veterans, Social Activist, NGO Heads, Media person with years of experience in serving humanity and having deep understanding on tobacco issues.

During the implementation period a total number of 24 State level and 45 District Level notification/orders issued by the department of health, tourism, education, transportation etc. Districts has been taking initiatives for promotion of Tobacco-free environment, District Magistrate, Uttarkashi announced an award of 1 Lac Rupees for the making of model Tobacco Free Village Panchayat.

With the active participation of the law enforcers, strict enforcement drives were carried out and a total number of 6870 violators fined under section 4 & 6 of COTPA 2003 in the project districts. A total number of 36 trainings and workshops were conducted at State and District level in which 2261 (incl. 1359 law enforcers) stakeholders trained, engaged, and sensitized and representatives from press media. Nearly 8000 Face Masks promoting No Smoking and No Spitting designed and distributed.





Implementing Tobacco-Free Educational Institution (ToFEI) guideline


The National Tobacco Control Program (NTCP) was launched by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India, in 2007-08. The objective was to bring about greater awareness about the harmful effects of tobacco use and about the tobacco control laws.

The second round of Global Adult Tobacco Survey (GATS2) was carried out in 2016-17 and its report was published in 2018. A 6% absolute decline in tobacco use has been observed in GATS2. This demonstrates the success of India's tobacco control efforts. However, tobacco use remains very high and these efforts need to be scaled up and sustained. New and emerging electronic products (e-cigarettes and like products) pose new challenges to these efforts. Given that the GYTS and GATS indicated that there is significant tobacco use among adolescents and young adults as they are most vulnerable to the exposure to tobacco use, the Government of India had released\launched\prepared the "Guidelines for Tobacco Free Schools/Educational Institutions" in 2008 and "Step by Step Guidelines for implementation of Section 6 (b) of the Act and Rules" in 2017.

Many new initiatives have since been taken. The GATS2 data has also suggested that there is need to review the earlier guidelines, hence these guidelines. Objective of these Guidelines is to provide a fresh momentum to implementation of tobacco control initiatives among adolescents and young adults. These guidelines may be implemented by any educational institution, including schools at all levels, colleges for higher or professional education and universities, both in public and private sector.

With this background BSS has been implementing the ToFEI guidelines in Bijnor, Shamli and Saharanpur district of Uttar Pradesh with the support of Department of Health and Family Welfare Uttar Pradesh and with the support of Narottam Sekhsaria foundation-Salaam Mumbai foundation in Dehradun District of Uttarakhand. In this program we are not only raising awareness among children but also engaging with the teachers and sensitizing them to take initiative of declaring their schools as Tobacco Free Schools.

Promoting Uttarakhand Tobacco-Free Coalition (UTFC)

BSS has been working in tobacco control programme from past more than 9 years in Uttarakhand with the support of The Union South-East Asia and Heath Department-State Tobacco Control Cell formed under National Tobacco Control Programme.. To sustain its effort and to expand the reach, BSS has been promoting a Coalition by the name of Uttarakhand Tobacco —Free Coalition (UTFC). UTFC is a group of Institutions or Organizations which is supporting State Tobacco Control Cell, Department of Health and Family Welfare in implementation of National Tobacco Control Program.

The broader objective of building coalition is to advocate for effective tobacco control program in the state, advocate for Tobacco free Uttarakhand at policy level, to provide strategic suggestions, ideas, thoughts to District Tobacco Control Cell (DTCC), State Tobacco Control Cell (STCC) on Tobacco Control. And also developing counter strategies against Tobacco Industries tactics.

At present, there are more than 30 members in the Coalition who are actively working for the tobacco control efforts and presenting them at various levels. A board has already been formed and they are meeting quarterly.



Promoting and raising awareness of adolescent girls and young women on preventive and promotive Reproductive Health care and access to health services

BSS implemented the project in Dehradun District with the support of Sharon Bio-Medicine Ltd. under their CSR initiative. The aim of the project is to provide information about all aspects of sexual, reproductive health and rights of adolescent so that they are aware of the changes they go through and how they should protect themselves against sexual abuse, STIs and HIV/AIDS. The project target beneficiaries were adolescents girls between the age group of 15-18 years and Young women in the age group of 19-45 years. In the project, we have reached 700 adolescent girls and women. We conducted various IEC awareness and Behavioral Communication sessions. We also conducted Health camps with the beneficiaries. 625 Adolescent girls and women benefitted directly and rightly informed on the reproductive health, STIs/RTIs etc. As a result of our intervention 40% beneficiary switched to better hygiene practices and 60% beneficiaries benefitted from the health camps and well informed on access to health services.





Water & Sanitation Program: Construction of Low cost Toilets for the Poor Family

In 1999, the Indian government introduced the Total Sanitation Campaign (TSC) to accelerate sanitation coverage throughout the country, particularly in rural areas. Despite efforts of government and non government agencies, people in most of Indian villages still go to fields to defecate. Most of the medium class families have a toilet in their houses but the poor are still deprived of this basic necessity.



Balajee Sewa Sansthan is constructing low cost toilets in Patna & other districts of Bihar. The poorest of the poor are selected for constructing toilets in their houses. Poor having no disposable funds can contribute to the toilet construction through labor. Balajee has wide experience of construction of low cost toilets and so far constructed more than 2000 such toilets in 32 villages in 3 district of Bihar Constructed in last 8 years. In the year 2021-22, the organization with the help of there volunteer have constructed 30 toilets. For the construction of these low cost toilets the organization receive donations from Give India Platform.

The Government Inter College, Badowala was taken up for the construction of toilets complex for 496 students (for both boys and girls) and for 22 staff by Habitat for Humanity. The groundbreaking ceremony for the construction of toilets for student was held at designated spot in the GIC premises by Regional head of Indo Star and Principal of GIC Badowala in Doiwala block of Dehradun district.

Self Help Groups Promotional Activity

A **self help group** is a rural poor group of **10-20** member constituted to organise themselves to eradicate poverty. Balajee Sewa Sansthan has formed more than 825 SHGs till the year 2021-22 by the financial support of NABARD, Dehradun & Lucknow Region. BSS all ready formed and linked with Bank of 50 SHGs of BPL family for DRDA Dehradun in Sahaspur Block. In last Year more than **115** lakh saving created by SHG members and utilizing for inter loaning among the member as per her needs and requirements





Self Help Group Meeting in Bareilly and Dehradun district

Objective of SHG:

Self-help group encouraged the women to save what little they could save, presently a minimum of 100 rupees each woman is saving, group members are involved in resource-sharing to make investments that have completely changed the prospects of the village's families. BSS focuses on women because they are disproportionately disadvantaged among India's poor—and extremely effective at creating change in their communities.

Credit Linkage:

More than 450 Self Help Groups credit linked with bank and disburse more than 360 lakh loan among them for their income generation activities. Balajee organizing group leader training as well as financial literacy training to the SHGs members. The concept of DBT has made it compulsory for all eligible people to give account with banks. The relative advantage of Uttarakhand Gramin bank and other nationalized bank of insurance of Rs. One lac in case of accidental death for all savings accounts holders was explained.

The team explained them the power of savings avoiding wasteful expenditure and build capital for a better future. Importance of Thoughtful borrowing, securing future by life and medical insurance and investing the hard earned money wisely. All they require is analyzing their needs, make a distinction between the need and desire, avoid wasteful expenditure and save for the future. A saving whatever small is a source of tremendous self confidence and helps in creation of wealth over a period of time. People who could not afford any initial amount to open account with Banks were advised to open NO Frill Savings bank accounts with Bank.

Impact: Within the span of 7 years of self-help groups, a powerful transformations in the women of different groups are visible. It is observed that they shed shyness and hesitation to become keen representatives for their communities' rights and aspirations. They are becoming more independent and confident. Till March 2020 more than 5000 women women become micro-entpreneur in her own home-based work and get self employment as well as many women empowered through this program.

Farmers Club Promotional Activities

Agriculture is the backbone of the Indian Economy as nearly 60% of the population of the country depends on agriculture directly or indirectly. Government has also declared to double income of the farmers in next three year. There is, therefore, an urgent need to provide package of initiatives for transfer of technology, improving input use efficiency, promoting investments in agriculture both in private and in public sectors and creating a favorable and enabling economic environment. The emerging needs in agriculture sector now are adoption of location specific skill and knowledge based technologies, promote greater value addition to agriculture produce, and forge new partnerships between different stake holders and making farming competitive as an occupation.

NABARD has taken an initiative to organize farmers in a semi formal group as Kisan club mainly to bring latest agriculture techniques to the their field, adoption of latest post-harvest handling technology, value addition, etc. and enjoy the benefits of collective bargaining power both for procuring inputs and selling their produce.

Balajee Sewa Sansthan is promoting 30 Kisan clubs in Dehradun district where more then 20 village and 1000 farmers cover under this program. by the financial support of NABARD. The NGO has a network of SHGs in a number of villages in Dehradun district. Through these SHGs we identified villages where the farmers have an progressive approach and can be mobilized to form an organization to discuss about different way of farming and supporting activities. Our field functionaries arranged meeting of the farmers and told them about the concept and benefits of the clubs. Interested farmers were identified and a group was formed to be known as kisan club of that village.

Regular meetings:

Members of the club are meeting at least once in a month. Non-members are also invited to attend the meetings. Besides agriculture they also discuss socio-economic developmental activities like community works, education, health, environment and natural resource management etc. The objective of formation of such group is to make technology available to all villagers and keeping that in mind non members too, are encouraged to attend the meeting of the clubs and give their suggestions.

Functioning of Kisan Clubs& Meetings with Experts.

Thereafter, as per the guidelines given by NABARD, accounts were opened in the service area banks, started their functioning, monthly meetings arranged, experts in agriculture and non-agriculture as well as Veterinary Doctor& Agriculturist from Krishi Vigyan Kendra, and Agriculture officers from Sahaspur, Doiwala and Vikasnagar Blocks were also invited in the meetings.








Farmers Producer Organization (FPO) Promotional Activity

The broad objective of the Fund is to build, promote and nurture Farmer Producer Organizations (FPOs) by way of extending the required financial & non-financial support during the nascent/ formative stage. It is critical to support FPOs in terms of awareness creation, capacity building, technical support, professional management, market access, regulatory requirements, etc. and provide handholding support for a minimum period of 3 years and the same is met as grant under the Fund. The requirement of the FPOs for their business has to be met out of their own funds, equity, credit, profit generated, etc.

In the Dehradun district's Doiwala hamlet, where more than 6 villages and 530 farmers are covered by this initiative, Balajee Sewa Sansthan is promoting One FPO. by NABARD's financial assistance. Doon Farmers Producer Firm Ltd., a company authorised by the Company Act, is located in the Dehradun district's Doiwala block. The FPO's primary activities include the selling of dairy products as well as other farm products such pulses, grains, spices, and vegetables. In the Sahaspur block of the Dehradun district, the organisation also manages Balajee Doon Basmati Rice Producer Company Ltd. and Doon Farmers Producers Company Ltd. These under the Companies Act registered farmer producer organizations serve the interests of their stockholders.

Every year, BSS welcomes a sizable number of interns from India and other nations. 30 interns from various institutions and colleges visited and worked with FPO over

Vocational Training/Skill Development Program

Vocational training courses – Tailoring/Dairy/beautician/handicraft / training Classes: Balajee Sewa Sansthan take up a systematic approach to conduct vocational training courses and provide necessary opportunities for skill development and overall development of learners. For the means of providing employment women must be given a skill set to be able to earn a living. Diploma courses in sewing- Tailoring, Beautician were conducted in the year 2021-22. The objective of these courses is to impart skills for employment and also develop entrepreneurship among women. With support of our generous donors like Give India Foundation for collecting donation from individual as well as corporate donor on their platform for fashion designing course of poor, with which we have trained more than 200 women this year.

After completing the successful training, Balajee Sewa Sansthan also arrange the credit to start the enterprise either by loan from Balajee or from any nationalized or rural bank. We will further help the people in providing backward as well as forward linkage for goods & services manufactured.

"Udaan"- Empowering Women through vocational training

Our initiative of empowering young women was supported by Sharon Bio-Medicine Ltd. under their CSR initiative. The project area seeks to support self-employment by offering relevant training and exposure tours, to promote employment-oriented vocational skills and training to young girls and women from the community, to raise awareness of social issues among young girls and women. The project was carried out with an emphasis on teaching 40 young girls and women who had no prior sewing experience or understanding how to do it by building 2 centres in the Sahaspur area of the Dehradun District's slums and rural locations.





Digital Going

Digital Financial Literacy Program





In urban areas people know and use various modes of digital transactions. They are aware of making payments by cards, internet / mobile banking and using it to some extent. But the concept needs to be made popular in semi urban/ rural areas where large number of people is still using cash for making payments etc. To take concept of digital transaction to the semi urban/ rural areas District Cooperative Bank asked us to conduct 100 such workshops in Dehradun district to educate people about digital mode of payments. People were advised to Making payments by cheques, drafts, remittances by NEFT , RTGS . Live demonstration of transactions representing sale / purchase by POS machine was shown by balajee team They were also told about the precautions that they should take while making online or cash less payments.

Balajee Sewa Sansthan organized 1046 FLP and dFLAP workshop in Uttarakhand, Bihar and in Uttar pradesh till March 2022 with support of NABARD, Uttarakhand Gramin Bank, DCB Dehradun and Haridwar, Uttar Pradesh Baroda Gramin Bank, Bareilly and with other banks. More than 78000 people benefitted through this campaign.

"Livelihood finance: For economic development of the Poor"

"Microfinance" is often defined as financial services for poor and low-Income clients. In practice, the term is often used more narrowly to refer to loans and other services from providers that identify themselves as "micro-finance institutions" (MFIs). Typical microfinance clients are poor and low-income people that do not have access to other formal financial institutions. Microfinance clients are usually self-employed, household-based entrepreneurs. Their diverse "microenterprises" include small retail shops, street vending, artisanal manufacture, and service provision. Microfinance involves number of steps right from survey of the localities ,meeting with potential clients, need assessment survey, Group formation and compulsory training of the clients, loan disbursements and regular weekly meetings for loan recovery and follow up.

Micro lending is done in a group of five clients which is known as Joint Liability Group (JLG). Loans are disbursed to the individual clients and members of the JLG stand as a surety for repayment by the members of that group. MFIs disburse Micro loans in cash and recover that in cash in monthly meetings. Personal touch with the clients through out the loan cycle and each member of the group guaranteeing repayment of other members in that particular group ensures full recovery of the loan amount. Our recovery rate is 99.88% and it shall be our endeavor to keep it at this level.

In year 2021-22, Uttarakhand Gramin Bank Prem Nagar Branch renew sanction of 10 Lac as CC Limit Dehradun district of Uttarakhand. BSS team disburse Rs. 21 Lac in last financial years among women beneficiaries and only 0.5% NPA or default counted in the year.

In last year no any new loan sanction for the program while RMK and UCO bank given term loan in last financial year.

E-LEARNING CENTRE- An Initiative of Smart Classes in Govt Primary School

Himalayan Gram: Raithal: A new Tourist Designation

Himalayan Gram, a tourism venture of Balajee Sewa Sansthan envisions improving the livelihood of the villagers by generating secondary income in means of rent paid by tourists for staying at their home. Tourists will be staying at the house of villagers and interacting with them to get to know the culture and traditions of Raithal and enjoy the local food. Rooms that will be provided to the tourists are renovated with all the necessary amenities such as blankets, bed sheets, pillows, carpets, western toilets and dining set etc.

Project has sustained and become one of the model village of Rural Tourism and home stay in Uttarkashi. More than 20 new farmers registered in home stay act and started successfully his tourism activities in Raithal village.

Consumer Awareness Program

Companies take advantage of consumers' ignorance or reluctance to ask questions about the product, take action in case of defect/ deficiency in goods or the services and continue cheating the people. Of late we have been asking people to raise their voices against such malpractices and ask for the right price of money paid by them. The NGO has been spreading the message on consumer awareness and rights of the consumers in many districts in Bihar, Uttar Pradesh and Uttarakhand. Financial literacy campaign gave us an opportunity to talk to people in more than 70 villages and beware of misleading offers especially in investments' and mutual funds. Consumer awareness essentially remains a topic of discussion in all our community mobilization programs. The NGO has made a point to help its members raise concerns of the deficiency in service or the product before appropriate forum. They also aware about the online banking fraud. Every year lot of people are made aware about this.

A Step towards a better environment

Renewal Energy: Solar lamp Distribution Program

BSS has distributed 800 solar lamps among poor school going girls and widow women in the Patna, Ara district by volunteers. Bihar state of India has an erratic power supply and in some places it is available for few hours . There are still many villages where electricity has not reached. Poor People are forced to use oil/ Kerosene lamps to perform their daily activities. Keeping the scenario in mind, Balajee Sewa Sansthan provide an affordable means of power supply to these people do their basic works life cooking, going to washroom, for children to study etc. From 2016, every year organisation provided solar lamps to the people belonging to these areas, specially to women and school going children by identifying their economic background. And Balajee continuously providing support to them.

Solar power can supply them electricity at night thus reducing dependence on kerosene or oil. The lamp shall not only light their homes, but it can charge mobiles.



Computer Training Course for Rural Unemployed youth in Bihar

The target area is one of the backward sub-divisions of Patna district of Bihar where the basic condition of children, youth, women and aged are deprived. Youth form 60% of the targeted slums & villages who are in need of some basic skill to become productive and creative. training centre. Our computer learning centre achieves outstanding academic performance, similar to private computer training institutes for the children with no costs to the students. These courses are financially supported by generous donors across India and Abroad. Apart from computer experts, our selfless volunteers make sure that each child gets the best knowledge about computers



Rural Mart: Marketing Outlet of SHGs and FPO product

For the Direct selling of SHGs and FPO product, BSS with support of NABARD open Rural Mart with the branding of Himalayan Rural Mart.

There are two Rural mart run by Balajee Sewa Sansthan one in Subhash nagar, Dehradun run by Balajee Satyam SHG for handi craft and other SHG product. Other Mart located on busy Near Anjali Guest House Gularghati Chowk, Nakronda- Dehradun road displays products made by women Self Help Groups of the area. Handicraft items, mandua and maize flour, spices, pulses and locally grown rice. Fresh dairy product and organically grown vegetables are available for sale in the mart. It shall deal mainly in local produce thus acting as an outlet to sell produce of the SHGs and local farmers. More and more items shall be added keeping preference of the clients.









E-Shakti Program: Digitization of Self Help Groups

With Support of NABARD BSS digitized 329 SHGs in Dehradun while 23 SHGs in Haridwar district in last year under E-shakti program. It becomes very fruitful in credit linkage with bank. Time to time training program for animators and field worker organized by the organization. BSS get best NGO award in 2018 under this program and Now this project in closed by NABARD in March 2022.

Maternal health program

BSS conducted Block and Village level camps on maternal health among our SHGs members in Dehradun, Haridwar, Bareilly and Patna District. In this program organization stressed upon health of women during pregnancy, childbirth,, and the postpartum period. It encompasses the health care dimensions of family planning preconception, prenatal, and postnatal care in order to reduce maternal morbidity and mortality. While there has been a decline in world-wide mortality rates much more has to be done. The effect of a mother's death results in vulnerable families, and their infants, if they survive childbirth, are more likely to die before reaching their second birthday. Participants were told be in touch with local health workers and discuss problems faced by them without hesitation. BSS also promote and aware for sex ratio of girls child and additionally aware the people about PCPNDT act.


